## WORKSHOPS

LEVELS ARE A GUIDE, PLEASE FEEL FREE TO ASK IF YOU HAVE A QUESTION REGARDING ABILITY OR WHICH CLASS YOU SHOULD BE IN.

Workshops on Saturday and Sunday will take place from 10.00 -12.00 and 2.00 – 4.00 and each group will have their own tutor. Each tutor will teach their group music from the commission piece 'Song of the Oak and the Ivy'. Corrina is specially adapting her piece for the Cromarty Harp Village participants incorporating all the various ability levels. This is a unique opportunity to work with the performers of the piece, and learn newly composed music in a level to suit you.

Music and audio tracks will be sent out in advance so you will have a good working knowledge of the music before you arrive.

The classes will concentrate on Section One: the Jigs and Section Four: Homecoming (slow air), Wedding in Greenwood and the Contentment Reel. This is a full-scale version, unlike the reduced Edinburgh International Harp Festival Section Four. This will be the first time this music will have been played by a mix of levels, and should prove an inspiring and fun learning experience in beautiful surroundings. There will also be the chance to session on the Saturday night, and come together on the Sunday to finish the weekend with a big play of the performance piece together.
