The Cromarty Ukulele Weekend is led by **Finlay Allison**, Senior Tutor with Glasgow Fiddle Workshop and a very well-known Scottish musician. All our workshops are 'stand alone.' You can opt to take as many or few as you wish, however, if you sign up for them all you will progress through a series of linked themes and develop a toolbox of techniques which you can apply to invigorate and develop your ukulele skills no matter where you are now. In addition, there is a one-off **Complete Beginners** workshop on Saturday morning so come along and give this versatile instrument a try! This year we also have a special gig on Saturday night featuring Finlay and Jimmy Ross: 'Which Side Are You On? The Life & Times Of Pete Seeger' and an opportunity for participants of the Saturday afternoon workshop to join in!

Workshop 1: It's Skiffle, Daddy-o - The Skiffle revolution set the scene for everything in the sixties, from The Beatles to Led Zeppelin. Get your uke out and find out what Lonnie Donegan meant to Jimmy Page and John Lennon!

Workshop 2: Pete Seeger for Ukulele - Famous for the banjo and twelve-string guitar, did you know Pete also played uke? Prior to their evening show 'The Life and Times of Pete Seeger', Finlay and Jimmy Ross will teach several of the songs in the show from a ukulele perspective, with strumming patterns and chord voicings to bring out that special voice only the ukulele can provide. Attendees at this workshop will be invited to perform a couple of the songs at the evening show, also open to the general public – if they would like to!

Workshop 3: Move On Up - Finlay shows you how to improve your technique and expand on your existing abilities. Building on skills you already have, you can open up the fingerboard, creating new sounds from familiar chord shapes and adding style to your playing. Time to move on up!

Workshop 4: Western Swing - Cowboy favourites but with a ukulele twist! From Hollywood cowboys to jazzy stetson-wearing sophisticates, Finlay will cover a range of western styles to strum beneath the stars.
